3. GRADING SYSTEM

FOR INDIVIDUAL MEMBER AWARDS, CHAPTER AWARDS, MERITORIOUS AWARDS AND DISTRICT AWARDS:

All bidders garnering at least 90% of the total score for all these categories shall be considered outstanding. In the event that no bidder reaches the required 90%, no winner shall be announced for whatever category.

FOR HALL OF FAME CATEGORY:

Attained after winning at least five times with the highest score in the bid for the outstanding chapter award until 2024 or its previous equivalent / past title of the award and the highest among the outstanding chapter/hall of fame bids from 2025 thereafter. In the event that no bidder reaches the required 90%, no winner shall be announced for this category.

4. The Outstanding World Architecture Day (WAD) Program and Outstanding National Architecture Week (NAW) Program remain integral parts of the UAP Meritorious Awards that will be featured during the Annual National Awards Ceremony at the National Convention on April 2025. Award recipients will be announced by the Commission on Governmental and External Affairs during the National Architecture Week – Philippine Architecture Month in December 2024.
