The 7th General Membership Meeting (GMM) of the UAP Qatar Chapter, held at Shaza Doha Hotel, offered an enriching series of presentations focused on fire safety and resilience in the built environment. The event featured three expert speakers, each providing valuable insights into different aspects of fire safety. Through insightful presentations and discussions, the event explored the intersection of design, technology, and engineering, providing attendees with the tools and knowledge needed to stay ahead in a rapidly changing field.

The first presentation, "Building Resilience: Advancing Structural Integrity in Fire Safety," was delivered by Engr. Alden P. Cayaga, PICE, a renowned expert in structural engineering and fire safety. Engr. Cayaga discussed how to design resilient buildings that can withstand fire hazards while maintaining structural integrity. His session highlighted the integration of fire-resistant materials, advanced engineering solutions, and fire safety systems to ensure that buildings are safe and resilient in the event of a fire.









The second presentation, "Fire Prevention in Construction Facilities: Strategies, Compliance & Best Practices," was delivered by Engr. Lloyd Christina Peneda, PSME, SFPE, a distinguished fire safety engineer with extensive experience in the construction industry. Engr. Peneda's talk delved into the critical importance of fire prevention measures in construction facilities, emphasizing how proactive planning and strict adherence to safety standards can minimize fire risks during the construction phase. She discussed the most effective strategies for preventing fires, including the use of fire-resistant materials, proper storage of hazardous materials, and the installation of early detection systems. Engr. Peneda also explored key compliance requirements, providing insights into local fire safety codes and international standards that construction teams must follow. His presentation underscored the importance of a comprehensive approach to fire safety—one that integrates prevention, compliance, and preparedness to protect both the workforce and the building.





The third presentation, "**Fundamentals of Fire Containment in the Built Environment**," was delivered by Arch. **Arecles Balde, UAP PIEP**, an expert in architectural design and fire safety. Arch. Balde focused on the fundamental principles of fire containment, stressing the importance of fire-resistant barriers, compartmentalization, and effective evacuation strategies in the built environment. He emphasized how these elements play a crucial role in limiting the spread of fire and ensuring the safety of building occupants.

Together, these presentations provided UAP Qatar Chapter members with a comprehensive understanding of fire safety in architectural design and construction. Attendees gained practical knowledge on building resilience, preventing fires, and containing them effectively, reinforcing the importance of fire safety as a key aspect of responsible architecture and engineering.

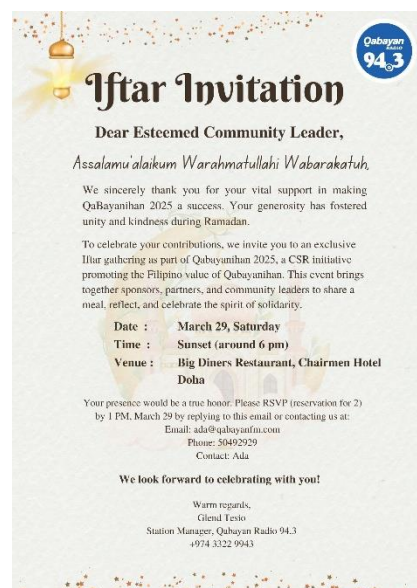
