




By participating, donors can earn points that can be converted into cash, which they can use for medical assistance. This program aims to promote environmental sustainability while supporting the health and well-being of the community.










PPO-Q 2025 along with UAP Qatar and other professional organizations in Qatar Meets with Philippine Ambassador to Foster Collaboration
